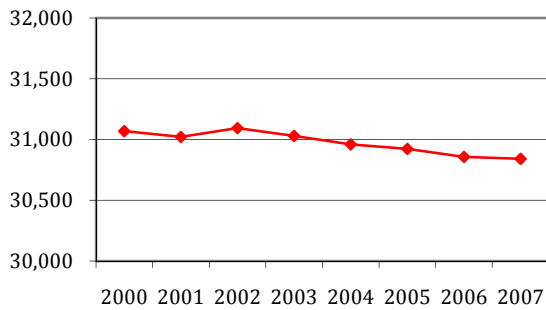


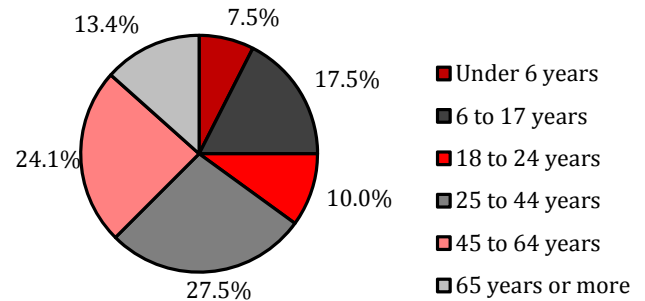

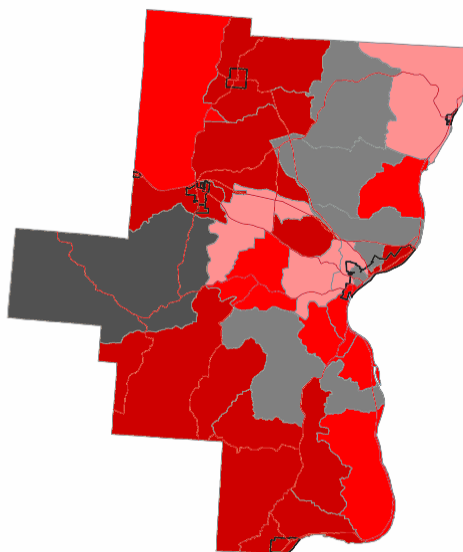


2000 Population % by Age<sup>3</sup>

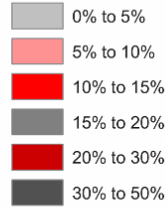

Percent of Persons Living In Poverty 2000



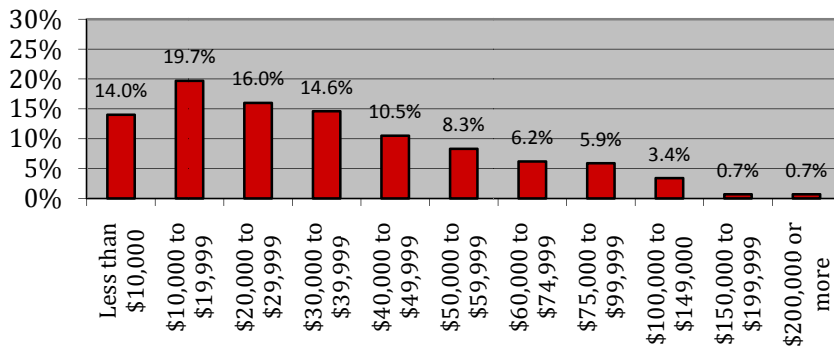

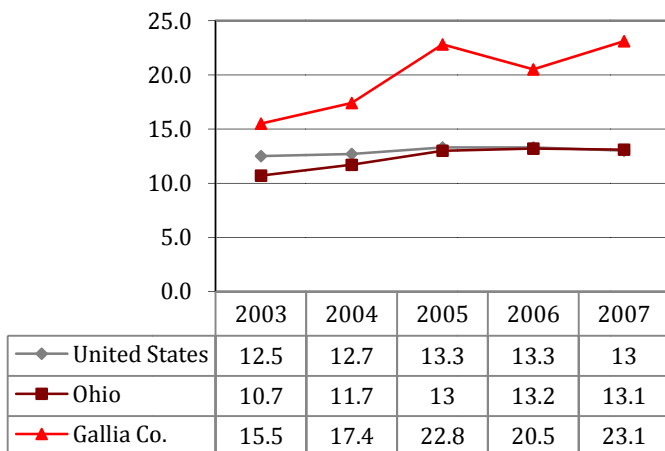

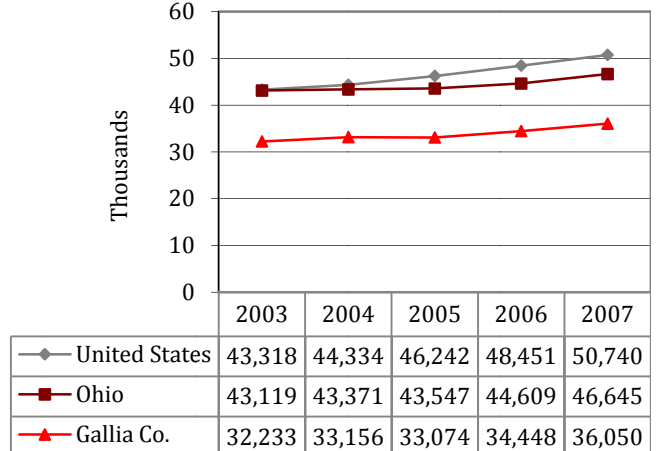
2000 Population % by Household Income<sup>3</sup>

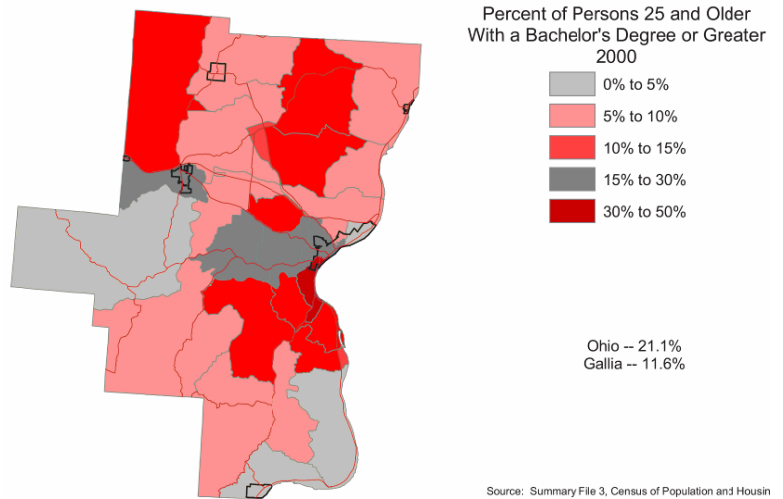

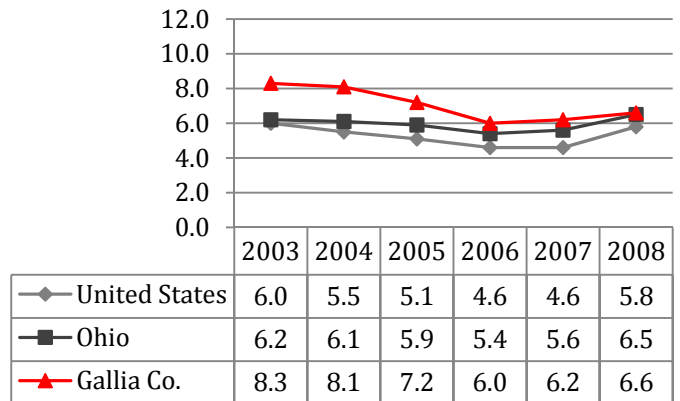

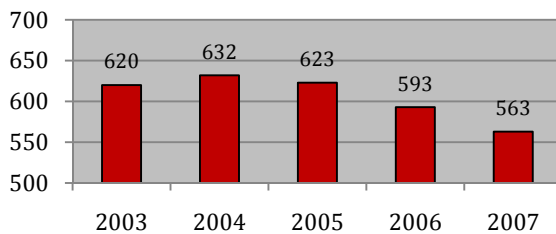

### Unemployment Rate<sup>3, 10</sup>

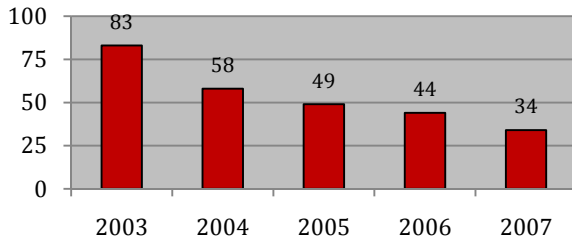

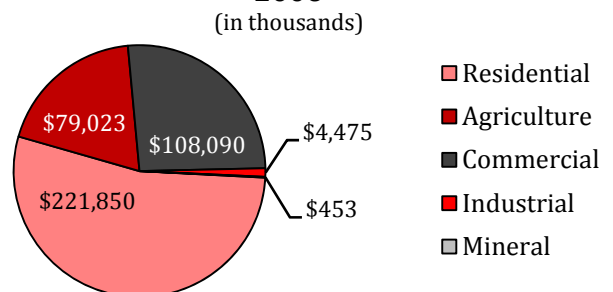
