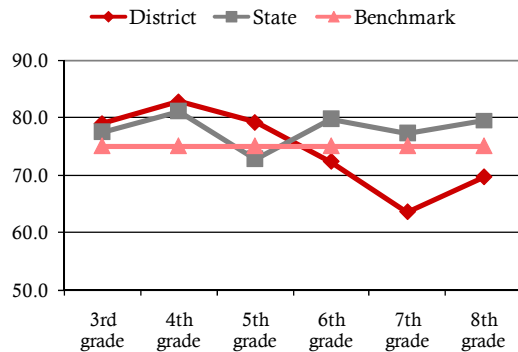

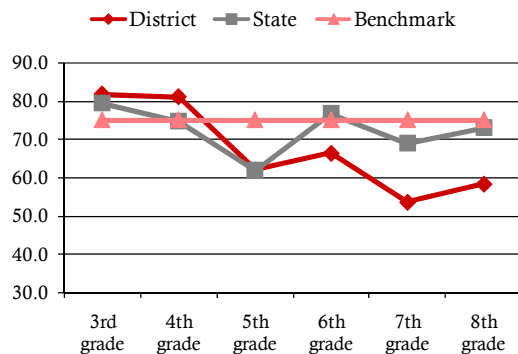
### Reading Test Results<sup>1</sup>

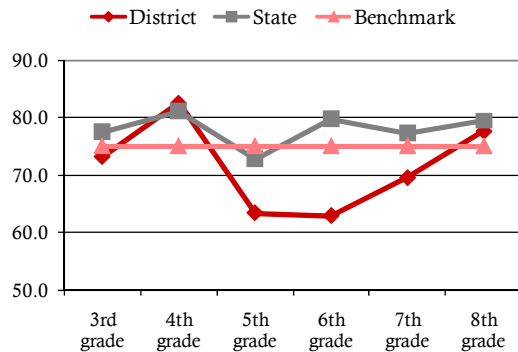

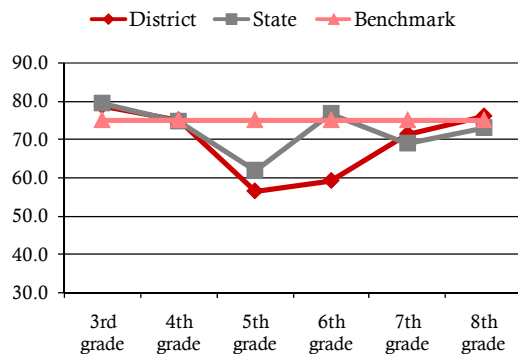
