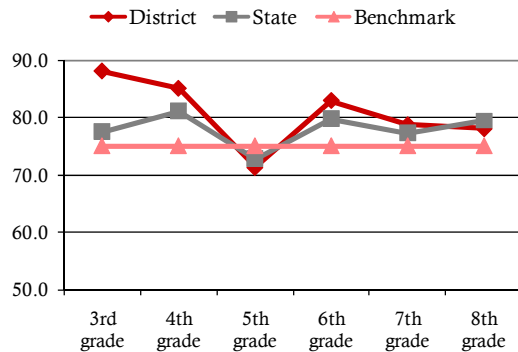

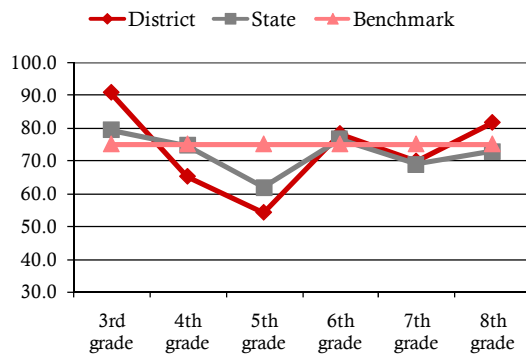
Reading Test Results¹

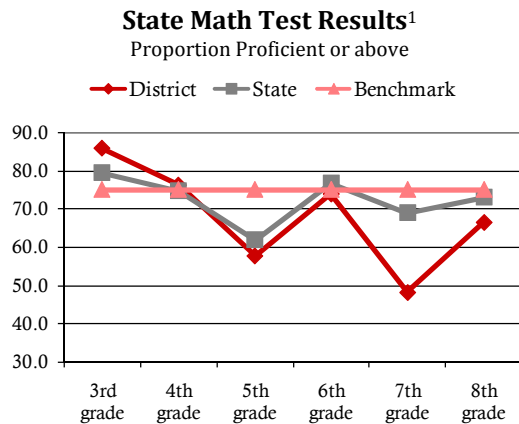
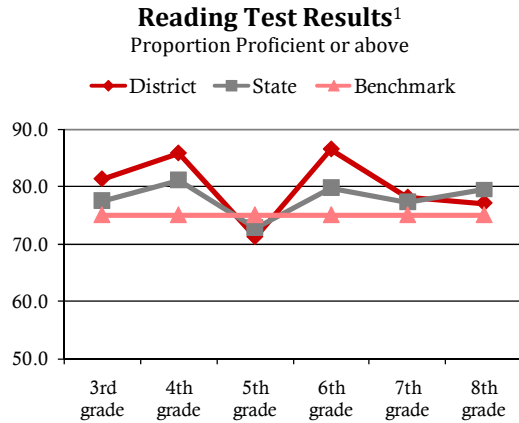
