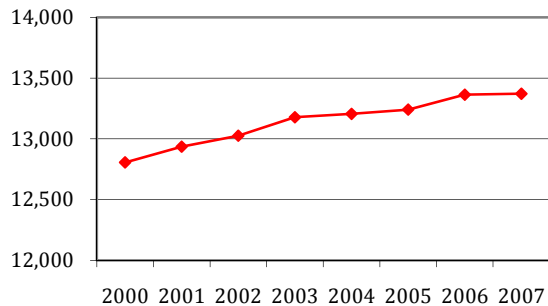


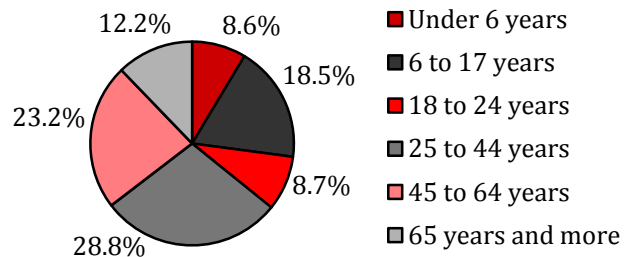

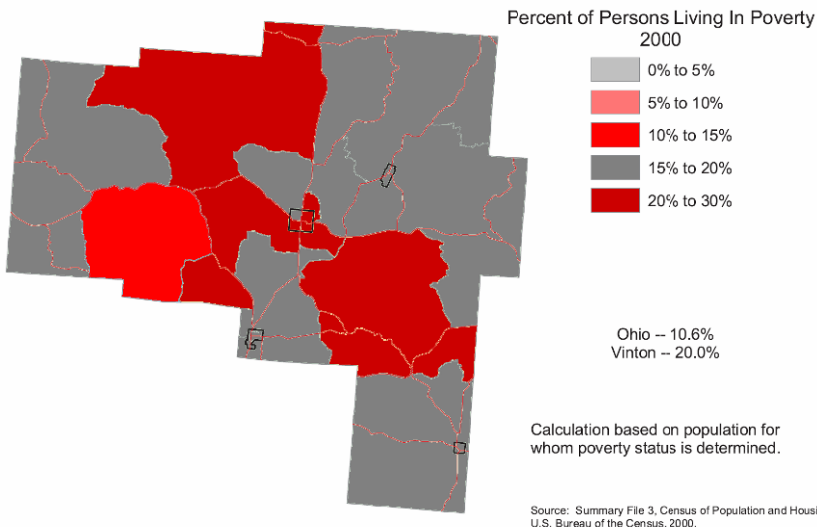
Estimated Total Population¹

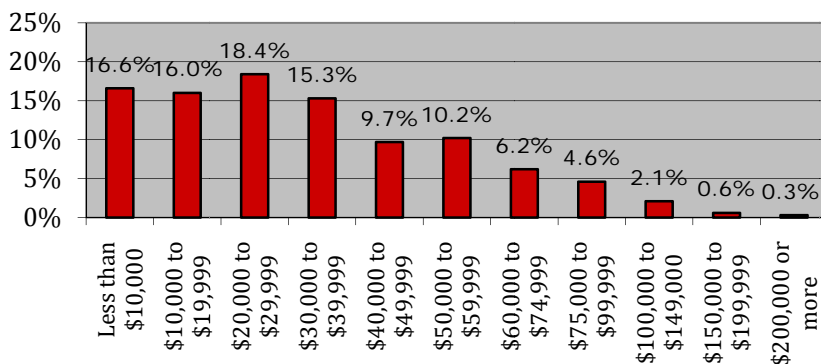

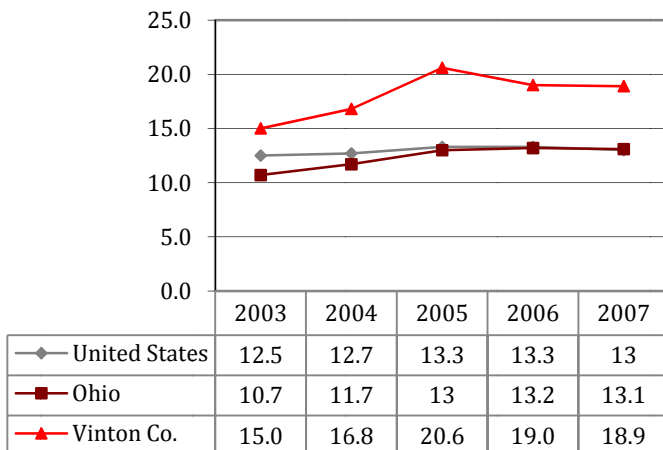

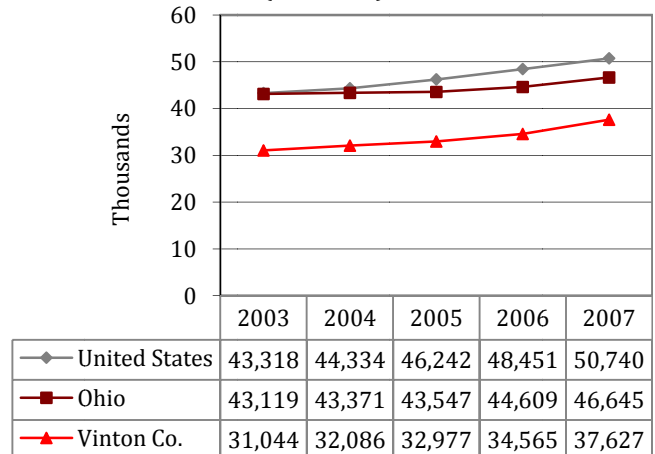
Percent of Population by Household Income³ 2000 Census

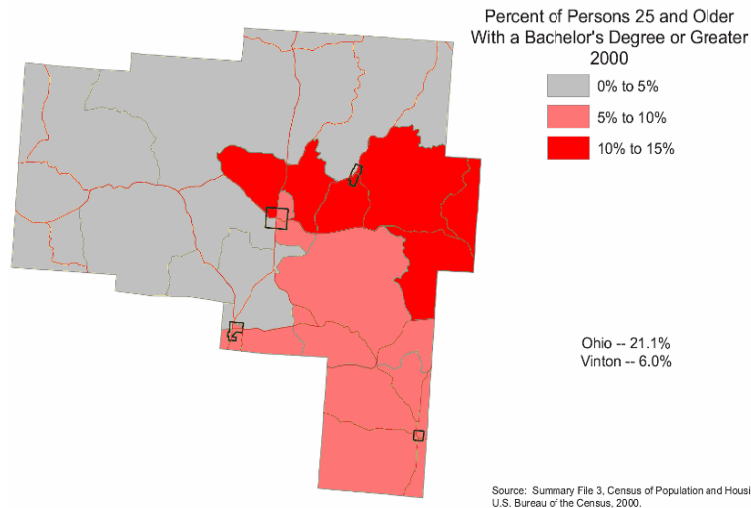

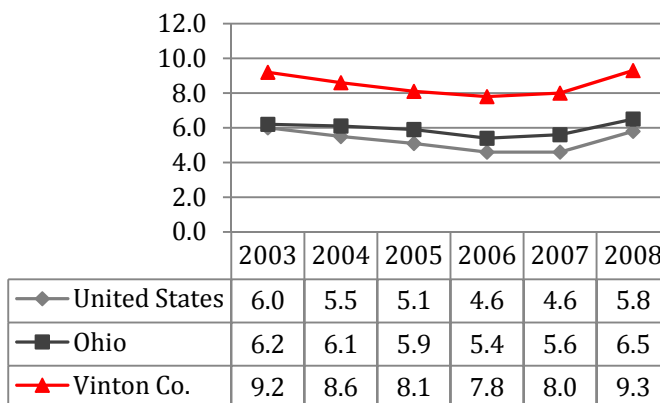

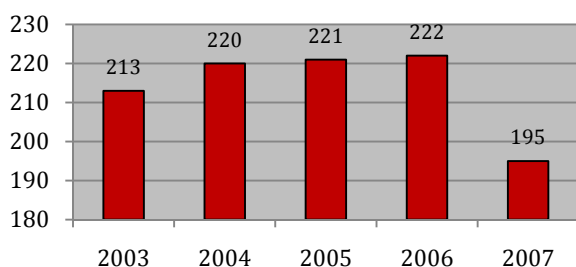

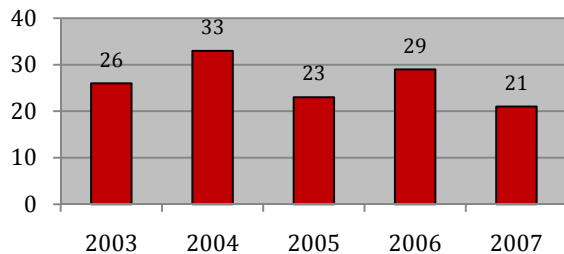


Business Growth³

Number of Business Starts



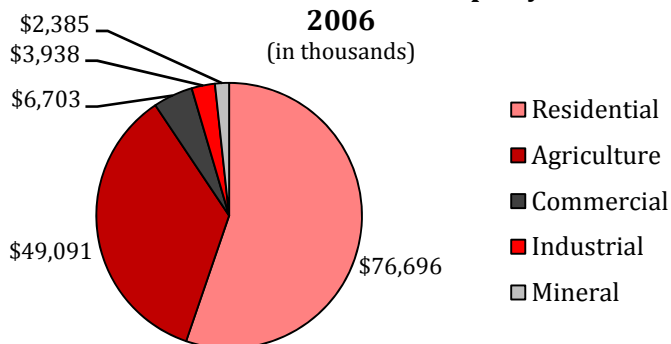
